**Delray Beach 30 minute Historical Walking Tour (561) 243-0223**

**Morikami Museum Japanese Gardens and Cultural Museum (561) 659-6555**

The Morikami Museum and Japanese Gardens offers visitors a glimpse of traditional and contemporary Japanese culture through a series of diverse gardens, world-class exhibits, and annual Delray Beach events. Be sure to stop by the critically-acclaimed Cornell Café for Pan-Asian cuisine and pick up a few unique souvenirs at the museum store.

**Delray Beach Tennis Center (561) 243-7360**

Tennis fans can bring their racket to the Delray Tennis Center, located just three miles from our Highland Beach resort, and enjoy a match on the center's 21 courts (both clay and hard courts available) along with professional tennis instruction and group clinics. This exceptional tennis facility also hosts several nationally recognized tennis competitions in their 8,200-seat stadium.

**Sandoway House Nature Centre (561) 274-7263 – walking distance from the hotel**

The Sandoway Discovery Center, offers a glimpse into South Florida's fragile marine and freshwater environments through educational exhibits and programs. The unique facility is an exciting hands-on learning experience, which focuses on Florida's fragile ecosystems and their inhabitants.

The nature center's activities include daily shark and stingray feedings, twice a week alligator feedings, garden walks, live animal exhibits, fossil digs and more.

**Cason Cottage Museum (one of Delray Beach's oldest houses). (561) 243-0223**

Come to 5 NE First Street, just north of Old School Square, and step back in time as you tour the Cason Cottage Museum. The tour features local history, South Florida lifestyle, climate, and architecture. The focus is on the years 1915 to 1935, with this historic house furnished as it was when a family lived there during that period. Cason Cottage is open from November through April. Docents offer guided tours from 11 am to 3 pm on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays. Admission is \$5 for adults, children under 16 are free. You may also tour the 1926 Florida Bungalow and the Ethel Sterling Williams Archive & Learning Center, a 1908 farm house adapted as a center for local research, exhibits, and the Historical Society's archive collection.
